PTB would like to invite you to participate in the announced **2nd EUMETRISPEC Stakeholder Workshop**. The workshop is organized by the EUMETRISPEC project which aims to establish a European spectroscopy infrastructure enabling measurements of traceable spectral line data under well controlled conditions at a central FTIR facility (CF) and at laser based satellite facilities (SF) as well as to foster the development, application and expansion of metrological codes which aim to provide well-defined uncertainties for all measured spectral parameters. Get together and mutual exchange of information and expertise between stakeholders in the atmospheric and environmental monitoring community, lab spectroscopists for spectral line data, and metrologists participating in the EURMETRISPEC project.
